- Dirt bikes/Restricted Use Motorcycles (RUMs)
- Truck box campers
- Park model trailers
- Boat trailers
- Golf carts
- Utility trailers with a GVWR of 1,400 kg or less
- Farm equipment (tractors, etc.)
- All-terrain vehicles (ATVs, and Quads and side-by-sides)
- Snowmobiles
- Boats and jet skis
